1. Donkeys' Years

Michael Frayn's cerebral farce about a college reunion is driven by an excellent cast (*pictured*). David Haig gives an exceptionally funny performance. Green Wing's Karl Theobald also stars.

2. 2Graves

Verse-drama is hardly in vogue, but that might change with Paul Sellar's stunning monologue charting a son's bid to avenge his father's death in the East End underworld.

3. Waiting For Godot

Last chance to see Sir Peter Hall's superb production of Beckett's dark, comedy. Hall directed the English language premiere 51 years ago.

4. Billy Elliot

The best British musical in many a moon follows a young working class lad from pit-town to pas de deux.

5. Mary Poppins

Another stage version which is arguably better than the film. Supercalifragilistic expial...etc.
